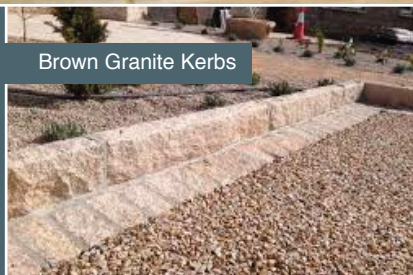

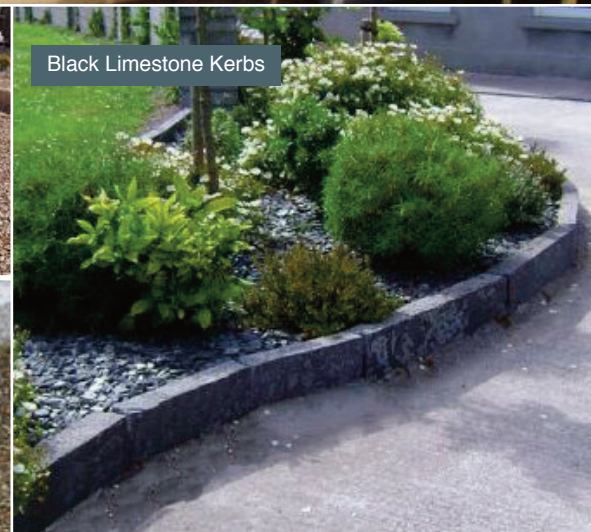

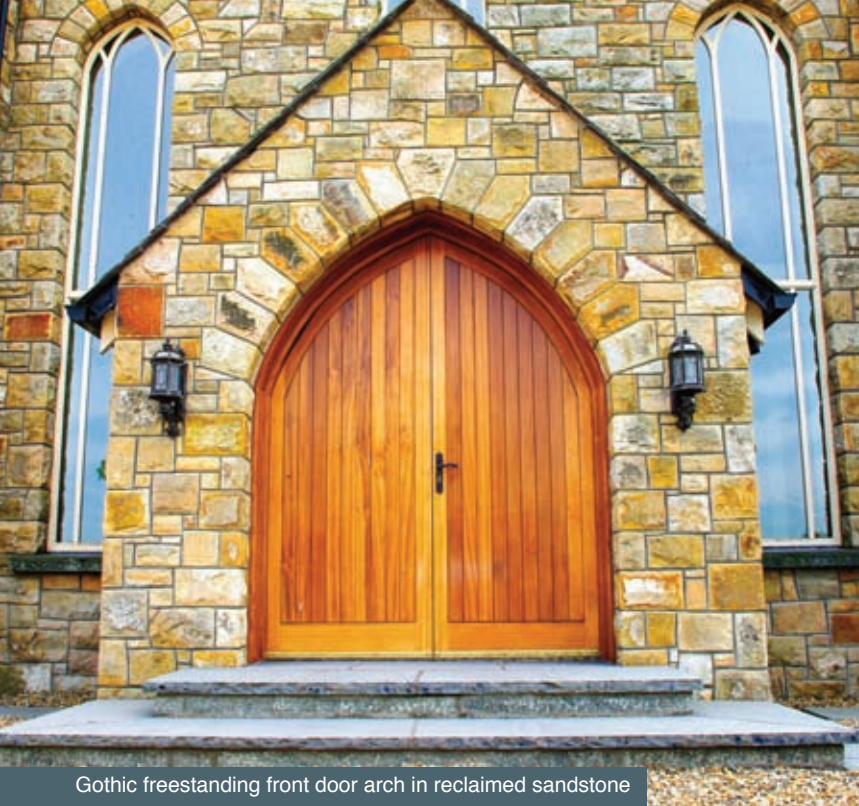
SANDSTONE

Sandstone is a sedimentary rock composed of grains of sand compressed together. Sandstone is resistant to weathering and durable, yet easy to work. This makes sandstone a common building material.

Sandstone can vary enormously in colour, texture and composition depending on the source material and the environment of deposition. Like sand, sandstone may be any colour, but the most common colours are tan, brown, yellow, red, grey, pink and white. Certain colours of sandstone have been strongly identified with certain regions.

LIMESTONE

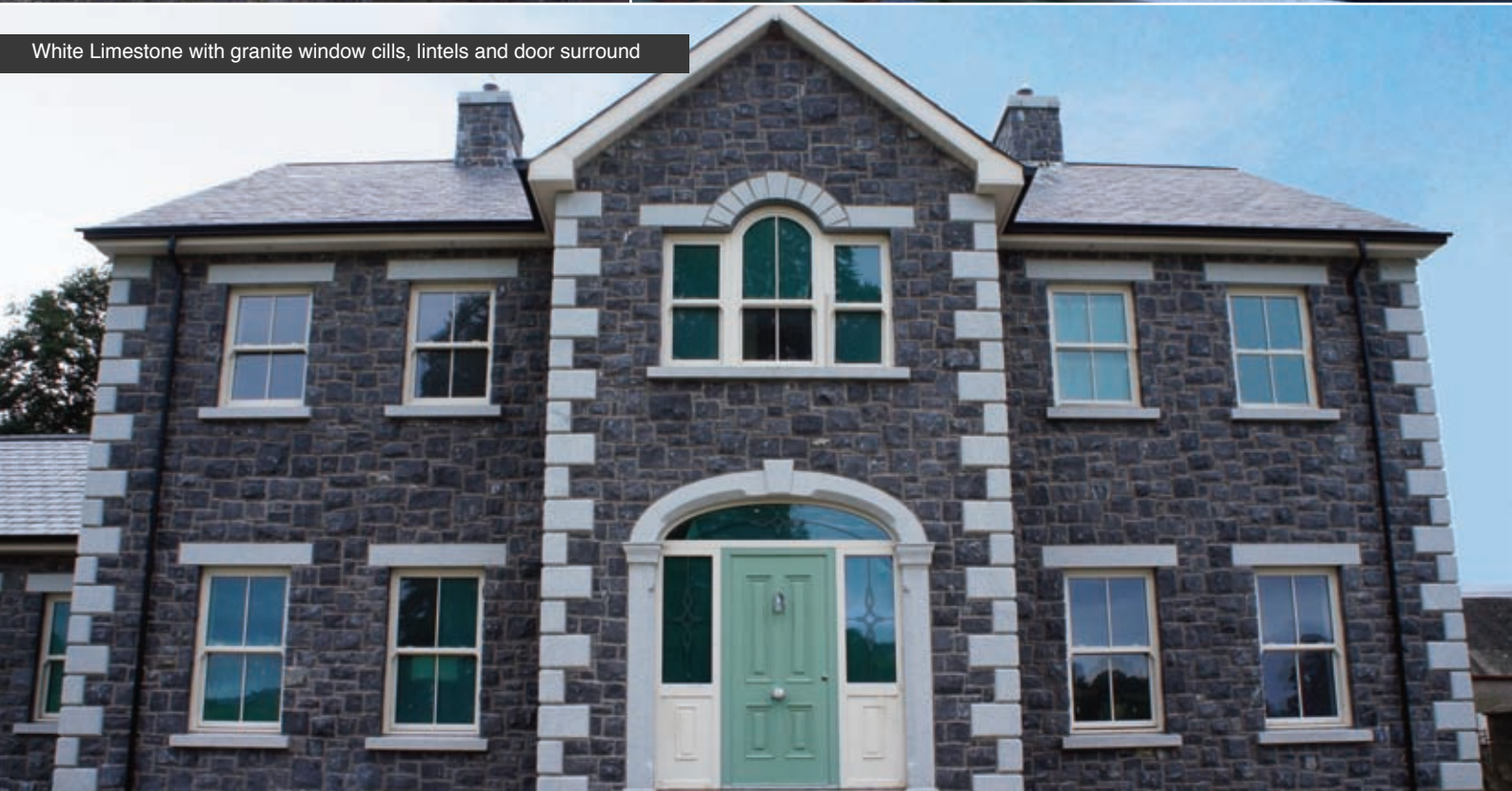
Limestone is very common in architecture, it is hard and durable with a texture which is soft and easily workable. Limestone suitable for both indoor and outdoor use.

There are many different types of slate dependent upon the clay from which they were formed. Slate is mainly blue in colour, durable and is suitable for indoor and outdoor use.

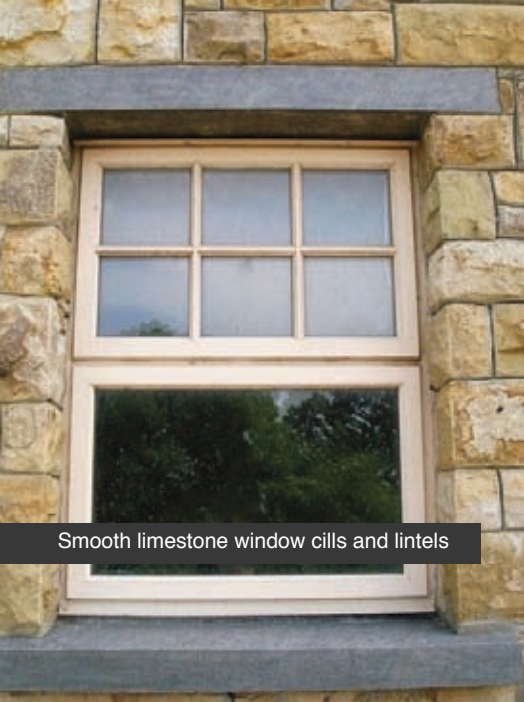

They can be provided with either a smooth or rock faced finish depending on the aesthetic that you are trying to achieve.

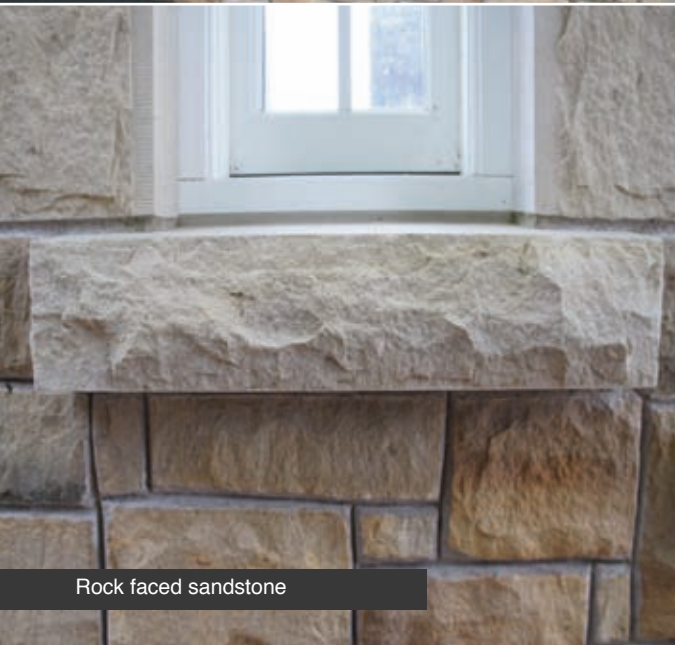

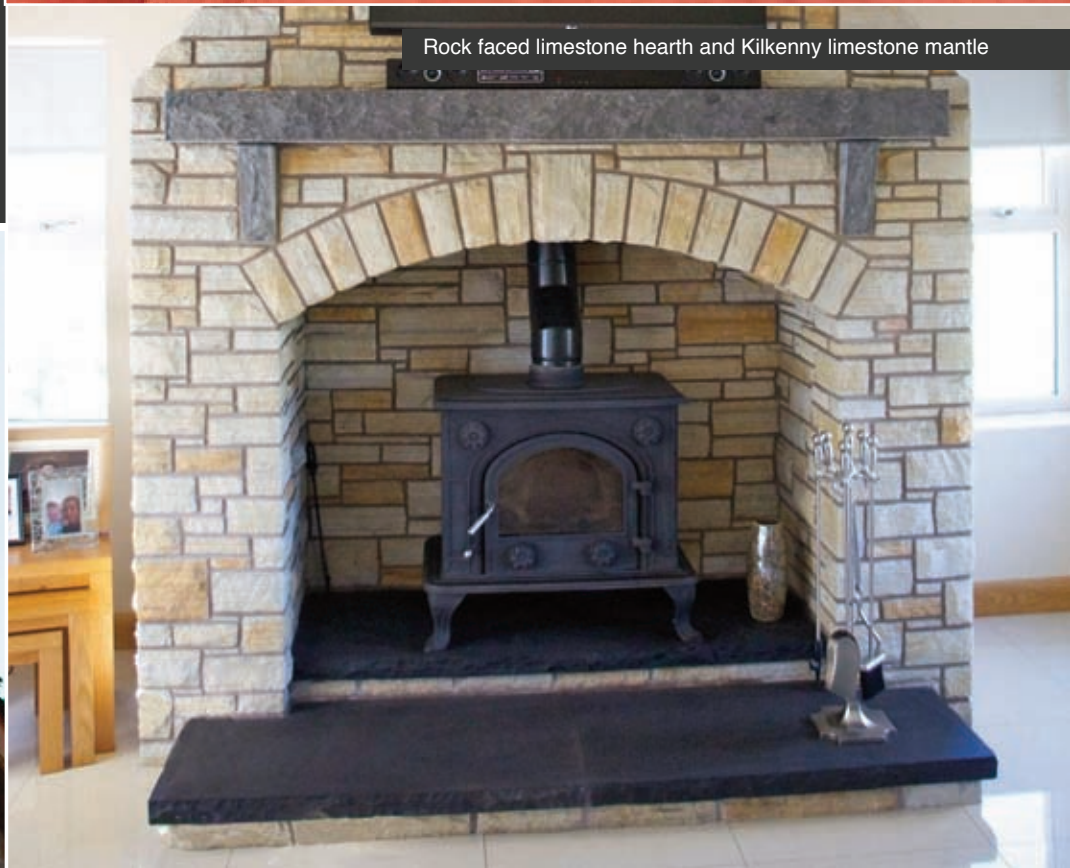
